## Transportation from/to the Airport

### By train:

“Elmas Aeroporto” railway station. The service runs from 5AM until 9PM with a **20 mins.** average frequency. The journey to and from downtown takes 5-7 mins, single fare is **1.25 €**. Tickets are sold by **Trenitalia** at the ticket counters and vending machines located inside the station, online and by authorized dealers. The airport train station is just a few minutes’ walk from the air terminal.

### By taxi:

The price from/to the airport is about 17/20 €

### By bus:

Bus ARST - Tickets (4 Euros one way) at a ticket dispenser inside the airport.

From ELMAS AIRPORT to CAGLIARI (ARST Station – Piazza Matteotti) - duration 10 minutes

From 08:45 to 22.45 every ½ hour

From CAGLIARI (ARST Station) to ELMAS AIRPORT

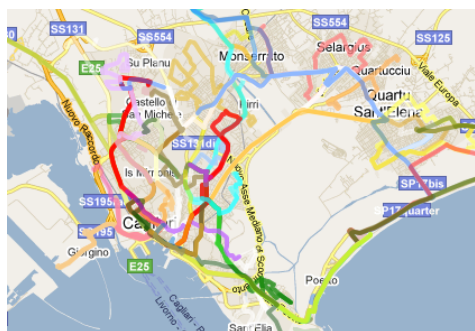
